

## 2020 Weekend Tournaments

	Tournament Name	Tournament Description
April 4 (Women's Opening Day)	Computer Pick, Front Nine Only	<i>Team play:</i> <b>Computer pick</b> the day before to determine foursomes & tee times; 2 better balls of foursome
April 11	Eliminate Putts	<i>Individual play:</i> Lowest net score, excluding putts, wins (count from tee to green)
April 18	Odd/Even Partners	<i>Partner play:</i> Before play starts, each partner elects to play either odd or even holes
April 25	Senior/Super Senior	<i>Individual play:</i> Low net, two divisions; Low Gross for each category are eligible for WGAP Tourney of Champs <b>Trophy Chair</b>
May 2	Throw out Par 3's	<i>Individual play:</i> Total net score minus par 3's wins
May 9	Three Blind Mice	<i>Individual play:</i> Three holes will randomly be selected by Weekend Chair to be thrown out for everyone's total score. Lowest net score minus these holes wins.
May 16	Dot Buchanan Memorial	<b>2020 Format = 3, 2, 1;</b> <i>Team play:</i> Three or four person team; on par 3's, use three players' scores; on par 4's, use two players' scores; on par 5's, use one player's score <b>Trophy Chair</b>
May 23	Flag Day	<i>Individual play:</i> Mark location where you reached even par with your handicap (furthest point reached wins)
May 30 & 31	President's Handicap	<i>Individual play:</i> Two day net tournament (Saturday & Sunday) <b>Trophy Chair</b>
June 6	Forty	<i>Team play:</i> Choose your own foursome and that's your team; each player must use ten holes (decide after each hole); total low net of forty holes wins
June 13 & 14	Women's Derby	<i>Partner play:</i> Two day partner net tournament (Saturday-chapman & Sunday-better ball of partners)
June 20	Trouble	<i>Team play:</i> Teams get points for the following: Out of Bounds, Water Hazard, Bunker, 3 Putt-All points are erased when a member on the team has a gross par or better on a hole. The team with the fewest points wins.
June 27	Hoffner (course closed)	N/A
July 4	Count Putts	<i>Individual play:</i> Count putts taken only on the green
July 11 & 12	Ladies' Club Championship	<i>Individual play:</i> Two day gross tournament (Saturday & Sunday) <b>Trophy Chair</b>
July 18	Even Holes Only	<i>Individual Play:</i> Lowest net total of even holes wins; <b>Course possibly closed until Governor's Cup clears tee</b>
July 25	Shamble	<i>Team play:</i> Computer pick (A,B,C & D); team selects the best drive after teeing off, then all four play their own balls from that position into the hole; each player must use her drive at least three times ( <b>if playing in threesome, player must use drive four times</b> ) <b>Course possibly closed until Men's Senior Gross clears tee</b>
August 1	Husband/Wife and Non-Married Flight	<i>Partner play:</i> Chapman
August 8	Shooting Stars	<i>Team play:</i> Mark a ball with a star on it; rotate the star ball in the foursome; count the net score of the player using the star ball; <b>original star ball must not be lost to qualify</b>

August 15	Hilda Daily	<i>Individual play:</i> Low net, play within flights
August 22	Mixed Member Event	TBD by committee
August 29	Purdy Memorial & Odd Holes Only	<i>Purdy Format TBD; Individual play:</i> Lowest net total of odd holes wins
September 5	Partners' Relay	<i>Partner play:</i> Choose partners before teeing off, indicating which nine each partner will use for score
September 12	Stableford, Computer Pick	<i>Individual play:</i> Player scores (net): one point for a bogey, two for a par, three for a birdie, four for an eagle, and five for an albatross; most points wins
September 19	Solheim	<i>Team play:</i> Day 1 of net team match tournament
September 26	Solheim	<i>Team play:</i> Day 2 of net team match tournament
October 3	Better Ball of Partners	<i>Partner play:</i> Lower of two net scores on each hole added up; lowest net score wins
October 10	Low Net, Two Putt Cap	<i>Individual play:</i> Cap at two putts; low net wins
October 17	Pair them Up	<i>Individual play:</i> Front nine holes are paired up with corresponding back nine holes. For example: 1 with 10; 2 with 11; etc. Compare the scores on 1 and 10 and take the lower of the two, and so on. Add up the nine holes selected for the total score.

October 31	Witches' Walk	<i>Individual play:</i> 9-hole tournament using three clubs and putter
